- d. Oakcliffe Greenway \$200,000 has been allotted for the Oakcliffe Greenway project from the Capital Budget. Our priorities as determined at our June meeting have been sent to Councilman Kraus.

- **g. Oakland Pride residential building –** corner of Forbes and Craft Ave construction expected to begin this summer; there have been no design changes from what we were shown.
- h. Residential Parking Permit Program Ordinance #2021-1867 was passed by City Council. Its implementation is unclear as more resources are needed for enforcement and administration. Changes include Dept of City Planning no longer being involved in making regulations and setting policy with unclear roles of Parking Authority and Dept of Mobility and Infrastructure to do so, developing hybrid districts, and new non-resident permit types for landlords, contractors, medical care workers, and childcare providers.
